- 3. Add sample data to the table and create and test queries for the following:
 - 1. Which flights are available leaving Houston and arriving in New York? (listed by cheapest to most expensive) (query name: Houston to NY)
 - 2. Which flights cost less than \$500? (listed by cheapest to most expensive)
 - 3. Which flights are on Southwest airline? (listed by destination city)
 - 4. Which flights are on Southwest airline cost less than \$500? (listed by flight number)
 - 5. List, in order by flight number, the flight numbers and prices for flights on Southwest.
